Lower School Athletics

K-5th Grade Spring YMCA Soccer - Signup Deadline Feb. 15

Great Hearts teams are now forming for K-5 Spring soccer in the YMCA recreational league.

The teams are coed, and there are three main age groups: 5/6YO (K&1st), 7/8YO (2nd&3rd), and 9/10YO (4th&5th), often referred to respectively as 6U, 8U, and 10U.

There is a fourth age group, 3/4YO (pre-K), also called "Small Fries". Some GH parents have expressed interest in forming a pre-K team for younger siblings not yet in GH; we have 3 kids so far, need 3 more for a 6 kid team. Practice & game times same as older kids.

The sign-up deadline is February 15 to give sufficient time to order team shirts before the start of games on March 2. Cost is \$60 for members of the YMCA, \$75 for non-members.

The season is scheduled to go from March 2 to April 20. There are 8 games in the season, all games will be played Saturdays at North Lake College. Practice times will be determined with your coach, although traditionally GH teams have practices at North Lake on Thursday evenings. Practices usually start a week or two before the games start.

You can sign up online and pay by credit card here. Alternatively, you can go in person to the YMCA, fill out the registration form and pay with cash, check, or credit card.

When registering, take **PARTICULAR CARE** to specify the school as **GREAT HEARTS**, and to specify the **CORRECT** shirt size.

Brad Bell has volunteered to serve as a liaison between the Great Hearts community and the YMCA to help in organizing the soccer teams and to help ensure the best possible experience.

We have increased participation over the 5 teams we had in the fall (almost 60 kids so far!), so **we are looking for more volunteer coaches**.

Note: While for K-5 Great Hearts supports & encourages sports participation in the YMCA leagues, in the end this is not a Great Hearts activity, but rather a YMCA activity. Since the kids like to play on teams with their friends, we set up "Great Hearts" teams, coached by volunteer Great Hearts parents, but that is not 100% guaranteed (unless you are a volunteer coach!).
