



## Capital Campaign Commemorative Naming Opportunities

### EXTERIOR OPPORTUNITIES

**Great Hearts Irving Campus** **\$2,000,000**

Exclusive opportunity to have the Great Hearts Irving campus named after an individual or organization. Permanent interior recognition will also be included.

**Upper School Academic Building** **\$500,000**

Exclusive opportunity to have the 7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade academic building named after an individual or organization. Permanent interior recognition will also be included.

**Lower School Academic Building** **\$500,000**

Exclusive opportunity to have the K – 6<sup>th</sup> academic building named after an individual or organization. Permanent interior recognition will also be included. The Lower School construction will be complete for Fall 2024.

**Gymnasium\*** **\$500,000**

Exclusive opportunity to name the gymnasium, which will be equipped for basketball, volleyball and other sports, include bleachers, and house locker rooms, weight room, kitchen, and performing arts space. It will also serve as the cafeteria. Permanent interior recognition included.

**SOLD Upper School Courtyard** **\$150,000**

Exclusive opportunity to name the courtyard, a space for students to enjoy lunch, recess, and outdoor class time.

**SOLD Upper School Portico** **\$100,000**

Exclusive opportunity to name the portico, the covered walkway at the Upper School's entrance

**Lower School Playground** **\$100,000**

The playground construction will be completed for Fall 2024.

**Upper School Flagpole** **\$15,000**

Three flagpoles will be erected near the entrance to the Upper School. Three naming opportunities available: United States flagpole, Texas flagpole, Mustang flagpole

**Courtyard Table\*\*** **\$10,000**

Students and faculty will have the opportunity to enjoy lunch and the occasional class outdoors in the courtyard.

<b>PENDING Administrative Wing</b>	<b>\$100,000</b>
<i>The administrative wing hosts headmaster and other faculty offices as well as the teacher workroom.</i>	
<b>PENDING Library</b>	<b>\$75,000</b>
<i>The library will welcome students for study, reflection and quiet conversations. The library will serve as a lunchroom until the gym is complete.</i>	
<b>Weight Room*</b>	<b>\$75,000</b>
<i>The weight room will be located within in the gym and provide space and equipment for students' strength and conditioning.</i>	
<b>Faculty Workroom</b>	<b>\$50,000</b>
<i>As Upper School teachers move from classroom to classroom, the Workroom is where teachers have the opportunity to get their work done in a collaborative, open-concept environment with colleagues. It is located in the administrative wing.</i>	
<b>SOLD Lounge</b>	<b>\$50,000</b>
<i>The lounge is a space for upper school students to relax, read, and converse.</i>	
<b>Humane Letters</b>	<b>\$50,000</b>
<i>The Capstone of a Great Hearts education, students study the Great Books of Western Civilization in Socratic Seminar. One of two naming opportunities available.</i>	
<b>SOLD Art Studio</b>	<b>\$50,000</b>
<b>Science Lab</b>	<b>\$50,000</b>
<i>One of two available.</i>	
<b>ESL Room</b>	<b>\$40,000</b>
<i>Dedicated room for English language learners. One available.</i>	
<b>SPED Room</b>	<b>\$40,000</b>
<i>Dedicated room for special education learners. One available.</i>	
<b>Academic Classroom</b>	<b>\$30,000</b>
<i>Eleven of twelve available.</i>	
<b>Conference Room</b>	<b>\$20,000</b>
<i>The conference room is in the administrative wing and is the primary meeting space for small groups of staff, families and committees.</i>	
<b>Interior Artwork</b>	<b>\$5,000</b>
<i>Paintings and sculptures will warm and beautify the school's hallways and common areas. Donors may choose from up to 27 pieces on Great Hearts Irving's wish list.</i>

<b>Multipurpose (MPR) Room</b>	<b>\$150,000</b>
<i>The MPR is a large space used for a variety of school gatherings for students and parents alike, such as lunch and PE.</i>	

**Administrative Wing** **\$100,000**

*The administrative wing hosts headmaster and other faculty offices.*

**Library** **\$75,000**

*The library will welcome students for reading, study, reflection and quiet conversations.*

**Conference Room** **\$20,000**

*The conference room is in the administrative wing and is the primary meeting space for small groups of staff, families and committees.*
