Q: Safety protocols in Athenaeum and/or Homework Club?

A: Just as during the day in the academy, you will see increased safety measures for Athenaeum and Homework Club such as:

- Daily health screenings of all our Athenaeum and Homework Club teachers
- Smaller group sizes in the classroom and on the playground as well as snack time inside the classroom to help limit group sizes
- Increased sanitization measures after the school day before scholars enter classrooms for After-School Programs.
- Increased hand washing and sanitization
- Minimization of shared supplies
- And a modified check-out procedure to allow for social distancing

Q: What will my student do in Athenaeum and/or Homework Club?

A: Each day in Athenaeum, scholars will have an opportunity for snack time, homework assistance which includes Spalding dictation, time to play with their friends as well as hands-on classical-based lessons and activities. Our Homework Club scholars also have opportunity for a snack time as well as time to freely interact with their peers in a social setting.

Q: How will visitors be managed in Athenaeum and/or Homework Club?

A: Special visitors to the Athenaeum program will be suspended for at least the first quarter. At that time, we will revisit the use of visitors in the Athenaeum.

Q: Do you provide snack for Athenaeum and/or Homework Club?

A: No. Scholars are given time to eat a snack. However, we are not able to provide the snack. We encourage you to pack a snack specifically for the after-school program daily.

Q: Do you provide tutoring in Athenaeum and/or Homework Club?

A: No. Athenaeum and/or Homework Club are not tutoring programs. We provide supervised homework time that includes teacher-led Spalding dictation for the applicable grades.
