

## Kindergarten Storybook Craft

*Option 1 below is the craft that our in-person students will be creating as part of the Storybook Festival. Our Distance Learners are invited to participate by making their own craft at home. Option 2 is an alternate version of the craft that uses no special materials.*

### Option 1: *Little Red Riding Hood* Stick Puppets

#### **Supplies:**

*Little Red Riding Hood* character images  
crayons  
4 craft sticks (tongue depressors)

#### **Instructions:**

1. Print the images on the following two pages. (If you prefer not to print, students may draw their own characters from *Little Red Riding Hood* on a blank sheet of paper, or a parent or older sibling may draw them for them.)
2. Use crayons (or colored pencils) to color them neatly.
3. Cut them out and glue each one to a craft stick.



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## Option 2: *Little Red Riding Hood* Paper Dolls

### **Supplies:**

*Little Red Riding Hood* character images (optional)  
crayons

### **Instructions:**

1. Print the images on the previous two pages. (If you prefer not to print, students may draw their own characters from *Little Red Riding Hood* on a blank sheet of paper, or a parent or older sibling may draw them for them.)
2. Use crayons (or colored pencils) to color them neatly.
