

College Credit Program

Beginning with the Spring 2025 Semester, Great Hearts Online and Great Hearts Irving are partnering to pilot a College Credit Program. Our program will provide Great Hearts Junior and Senior scholars an exceptional opportunity to earn college credit while completing their current Humane Letters courses. Scholars will earn college credit through a partnership with Western Texas College (WTC).



How it Works

- 1 Scholars can opt in to earn college credit by completing the registration process online- link to register coming soon! Note: Payment is due at the time of registration.
- 2 Scholars will attend the Humane Letters course at their Great Hearts campus without any changes to their current HL course.
- 3 Scholars will complete 3-5 college assignments in Canvas, the online Learning Management System. Note: Work and experiences from Humane Letters courses may be used to complete these assignments.
- 4 A Great Hearts Online faculty member, approved by WTC, will grade the assignments based on the rubrics and learning outcomes of the course.
- 5 Scholars will receive a High School letter grade based on their performance in the Humane Letters course.
- 6 Scholars will receive a college letter grade based on their performance on the 3-5 assignments in Canvas and completion of the Humane Letters course.

Scholars will collaborate with a GH Online teacher, who will help guide them in submitting their work via an online Canvas course. This teacher, approved by WTC, will be responsible for evaluating the college-level assignments, providing feedback, and assigning final grades.
