AP EXAMS

Eligibility: All Great Hearts students 9-12

Cost: \$150 per test (includes exam and proctor fees)

Credits: 3+ credits per exam depending on score and college policies

Length: 120-180 minutes

Registration: Register and pay for AP exams through your Configio account.

DUAL ENROLLMENT

Subjects:

- 11th Grade
 - English 1301 – Composition I (Humane Letters)
 - Philosophy 2306 - Ethics (Humane Letters)
- 12th Grade
 - English 1301 – Composition I (Humane Letters)
 - Speech 1315 – Public Speaking (Senior Thesis Presentation)

Eligibility: Minimum GPA of 3.0 or approval

Cost: \$300 for each course


Credits: 3 credits per course

Length: 120-180 minutes

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DUAL ENROLLMENT

Dual enrollment can be earned in 11th and 12th grade Humane Letters through Western Texas College. Great Hearts students must have a 3.0+ unweighted cumulative GPA or approval to participate. Please note that grades earned through dual enrollment become part of the student's permanent college record/transcript. Not all colleges accept dual enrollment credits. Check with schools you may want to attend to determine potential transferability. After registration is complete and paid on Configo, NO REFUNDS will be issued.

CLEP TESTS

Students must earn a passing score to receive college credit for the test, which varies by college. It is recommended that students take only the test(s) they are most confident in and invest ample time studying. Not all colleges accept CLEP exams. Before taking CLEP, research each college's CLEP policy and course equivalency guide. For example, Texas A&M University's course equivalency guide explains how CLEP exams translate to credit ([https://testing.tamu.edu/exams/college-level-exam-program-\(clep\)/clep-course-equivalence](https://testing.tamu.edu/exams/college-level-exam-program-(clep)/clep-course-equivalence)). Free study resources are available through Learn.ModernStates.org. Upon successful completion, students receive a voucher for a free CLEP test.

AP EXAMS

Students do not need to be enrolled in an AP class to take the AP exam; however, Great Hearts courses do not precisely align with AP curriculum. It is recommended that students invest time to prepare for the exam. In order to receive credit for an AP test, students typically need to score at least a 3, 4, or 5. Not all colleges will accept AP exams. Before taking AP exams, research each college's AP policy and to credit: https://catalog.asu.edu/credit_exam. Free College Board test prep tool available through KHAN Academy.

It is the responsibility of the student to research and determine how AP, CLEP, and dual enrollment credits may or may not transfer to their future 4-year college or university.
