

## Western Civilization Day Costume Guidelines

Students in every grade level are encouraged to come to school dressed up in costume for Western Civilization Day. They do not need to wear their uniforms under their costume, though their costume does need to be appropriate for school. Students who choose not to come in costume must wear their normal school uniform. Each grade level is celebrating its own topic or period in Western History. Student costumes should reflect the theme for their grade level:

Grade Level	Costume Ideas
Kindergarten	Kinder Gardenters, taking care of the Garden
1st Grade	Ancient Egypt
2nd Grade	Ancient Greece
3rd Grade	Ancient Rome
4th Grade	The Middle Ages
5th Grade	The Renaissance

Please keep in mind the following questions as you prepare your costumes:

- Will my child trip?
- Can he/she still use the restroom easily?
